## **Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement**

This is how we stay safe when we use computers:

• I will not tell other people my Seesaw Code

I will not give out my own/others details such as name, phone number or home address.

• I know all my work/images/videos are approved by my teacher on Seesaw.

• I will only share videos/images of my family with my parents/carers consent.

• I will wear appropriate clothing for the images and videos

• I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe

• I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset any member of the school community

• I know that my use of ICT can be checked and my parent/carer contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my safety

• I will not sign up for any online service unless this is an agreed part of a school project approved by my teacher
